

## B. What about baptizing children or babies?

The Bible is silent about babies being baptized, it only speaks of believers, people old enough to place their faith and trust in Jesus Christ.

We believe that baptism is for those who have surrendered their life to the Lord Jesus Christ and it is required for everyone who desires to be a member of our church.

Children who are old enough to be saved (i.e., understand salvation) must have their parents' permission and complete understanding that baptism does not save them.

#### V. WHEN SHOULD I BE BAPTIZED?

## As soon as you have believed!!

"Then those who gladly received His Word were baptized; and that day about three thousand souls were added to them."

Acts 2:41

"And the eunuch answered Philip and said, "Please tell me, of whom does the prophet say this? Of himself, or of someone else?" And Philip opened his mouth, and beginning from this Scripture he preached Jesus to him. And as they went along the road they came to some water; and the eunuch said, "Look! Water! What prevents me from being baptized?" [And Philip said, "If you believe with all your heart, you may." And he answered and said, "I believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God."] And he ordered the chariot to stop; and they both went down into the water, Philip as well as the eunuch; and he baptized him.

There is no reason to delay. As soon as you have decided to receive Christ into your life, you can and should be baptized. If you wait until you are "perfect", you'll never fell "good enough"!

## THE MEANING OF THE LORD'S SUPPER

Jesus never asked His disciples to remember His birth. But He did instruct them to remember His death and resurrection. He gave the church two visible symbols (called "ordinances") as reminders of His death. These two ordinances are: Baptism and the Lord's Supper (or Communion). The Lord's Supper is an object lesson that represents a great spiritual truth for believers.

At Springfield Baptist Church, we practice it three or four times a year in a morning service.
